“Of course YRF obliged from 13<sup>th</sup> February 2015. However, while the theatre management was happy to continue the film for as long as it continued to draw in the audiences, owing to logistical issues of their staff having to work inordinately long hours to accommodate an additional early morning show, it was mutually decided to end the films historic and record breaking run”, it said in a statement.

The cult romantic film, which marked the directorial debut of Aditya Chopra, completed its 1000 weeks in December last year.

Shah Rukh and Kajol had got together at the Yash Raj Films studio on the occasion to relive many moments of the film, which catapulted them to the star status.
